

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Acceptance in the STREAM into College Program is on a competitive basis. The admissions committee is looking for mature, academically motivated students who meet the following criteria:

- 1. You must be in G10/seconde (class of 2026) or G11/premiere (class of 2025).
- 2. Scan your report card of the last academic year you have completed.

 Scan your report card of G10 if you are graduating in 2025 and your G9 report card if you are graduating in 2026.
- 3. Write a motivational essay (300 words max). Address the following points:
 - What do you like about the STREAM into College Program? Give specific reasons.
 - How will this program help you with your future plans?
 - Speak about your past experiences (academic and extracurricular) that make you a good candidate for this program.

PROGRAM TUITION AND PAYMENT METHOD

The program tuition is USD 1,900. This amount should be settled in CASH before May 31, 2024. The tuition includes all the needed lab supplies, but it doesn't include the cost of the official SAT exam fee.

FINANCIAL AID

Scholarships are available for students who are accepted but don't have the financial means to attend the program. Priority will be given to students from public high schools.
